*As part of an innovative proof of concept pilot, the candidate as an employee of H-N REACH will provide psychotherapy to children and youth and their families working as part of a multi-disciplinary team in partnership with Community Addictions and Mental Health Services of Haldimand and Norfolk (CAMHS). The aim of the pilot is to help improve access to high-quality mental health and addictions care. Service will be provided at various satellite offices through the counties and will include a multidisciplinary team of mental health and addictions service providers, as well as appropriately trained social workers and/or nurse practitioners who can deliver a wide range of services, including intake and brief services, referrals to existing services, and psychiatric support and follow-up.*

**Responsibilities:**

- Provide in-person and/at times virtual mental health competency-based psychotherapy to children, youth and their families using various modalities including individual, family and play therapy
- Completion of program related clinical documentation and assessments
- Service coordination and consultation with community partners
- Participation in Agency and community initiatives including workshops and community committees.

- Bachelor's degree in the Social Sciences or acceptable equivalent
- Registered to perform the Controlled Act of Psychotherapy in the province of Ontario
- Experience in counselling/therapy with children and their families
- Experience with quick access, brief therapies is an asset
