ORIENTATION FOR AUTISM SPECTRUM DISORDER

Families will receive information about Autism Spectrum Disorder, available services and the Applied Behaviour Analysis approach to services. This will include what H-N REACH can offer as well as other services in the community.

REGISTRATION TO CENTRAL INTAKE REGISTRATION TEAM (CIRT) AND INITIAL GOAL PLANNING

A H-N REACH Family Service Coordinator will assist with registration for the Ontario Autism Program. A follow up meeting for goal setting can also be arranged at no charge.

ASSISTANCE WITH CHILDHOOD BUDGET/ONE-TIME FUNDING

A H-N REACH Family Service Coordinator will assist with identifying eligible expenses, filling out your expense form and information on moving into the new needs-based program.

BEHAVIOURAL CONSULTATIONS

Behavioural consultations can be arranged with a qualified Autism Clinician to learn tips and strategies for building skills and reducing challenging behaviours

Includes: One consultation session, 1-2 follow up appointments, materials (visual schedules, tip sheets etc.) are also included.
