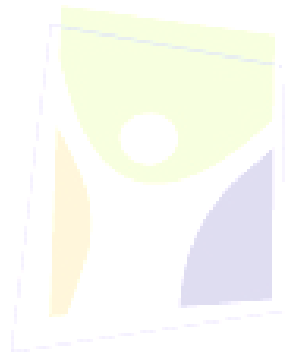

He has played concerts and recorded in Holland, Germany and Belgium with his daughter Rose and son Zander (who was named 'Drummer of the Year' at the 2012 Hamilton Music Awards). Rob's Los Angeles/Nashville/Dunnville-based band, The Riverdogs, released their new CD in July, 2017.

This Summer will be Rob's 14th year as Artistic Director of the Songwriting Faculty at Interprovincial Music Camp, near Parry Sound, Ontario. Rob is currently playing guitar in Award-winning Indigenous singer Logan Staats band. Rob heads to Europe in Late October, 2018, to play solo shows in Netherlands, Belgium and the UK.

Rob is most proud of his children and the 'Haldimand County Volunteer of the Year' Award he and his wife were presented with in 2010.
