This Summer (2017) will be Rob's 12th on the Songwriting Faculty he leads at Interprovincial Music Camp, near Parry Sound, Ontario.

Rob is most proud of his children and the 'Haldimand County Volunteer of the Year' Award he and his wife were presented with in 2010.
