**Responsibilities:**

- Work in collaboration with the Young Parents Outreach Worker, Healthy Babies/Healthy Children Family Home Visitor, contract Dietitian, partner agencies and community resources.
- Provide food supplements and prenatal vitamins to participants, as needed and the maintenance of proof regarding participant use.
- Coordinate individual assessments with Dietitian as well as ongoing consultation regarding participant nutrition.
- Establish connections with Public Health Nurses and other community agencies to provide program information, access referrals, and identify ongoing areas of need.
- Assist the parent in the assessing of their infant's healthy development and in assessing required community services

**Qualifications:**
